PRE-UNIVERSITY PROGRAMME (PUP)
SEPTEMBER 2010 INTAKE

Applicants must read the instructions carefully before completing the 'Application for Admission, Pre-University Programme.

1. Applicants must be 16 years old on or before September 1st of the year in which they plan to start the programme.
2. The deadline for the submission of application forms is **Friday 30th April 2010.**
3. The application form must be completed in **BLOCK LETTERS ONLY.**
4. The Application Form must be submitted with the following:
 - ✓ Non-refundable application fee of TT\$90.00 for applicants from Trinidad & Tobago, US\$15.00 for applicants from CARICOM and US\$25.00 for international applicants. Trinidad & Tobago applicants must make payments via bank deposits at any branch of FCB – Account #142-9625, prior to returning completed application forms. A bank copy of the deposit slip must be submitted with the application form. CARICOM and international applicants must make payments via international money order or international bank draft made payable to The University of Trinidad and Tobago.
 - ✓ One copy of Birth Certificate
 - ✓ One copy of **ALL** relevant certificates; CXC (CSEC), GCE, etc.
5. Applicants must present **ORIGINAL** certificates upon acceptance.
6. Only **OFFICIAL** transcripts will be accepted. Transcripts must be mailed to the following address:

- ✓ A minimum Grade III CXC (CSEC) General Proficiency – from 1998 will be accepted.
- ✓ For compulsory or optional components not offered as part of the curriculum for the Pre-University Programme, but is a required subject for entry into the diploma of your choice. Applicant must privately obtain the required subject.
